

CITY OF LAKE WORTH
REQUEST FOR COMPETITIVE SEALED PROPOSALS

Competitive Sealed Proposals addressed to the City of Lake Worth, Texas will be received at the Lake Worth City Hall until **10:00 AM FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 24, 2017** for the purpose of furnishing all labor, materials and equipment and the performing of all work required in the construction of the 2017 LAKE WORTH SANITARY SEWER REHABILITATION PROJECTS and other improvements incidental thereto, at which time and place, the proposals will be publicly opened and read aloud and retained by the City for tabulation, checking and evaluation. This project's Base Bid includes the replacement of 4,000 LF of 6" to 8" sanitary sewer line (PVC, HDPE), associated manholes, services and asphalt at seven (7) different project site within the City of Lake Worth. Installation methods for the base bid includes open cut and pipe bursting construction methods. There are four (4) Additive Alternate bids which includes the replacement of 3,100 LF of 6" to 8" sanitary sewer line (PVC, HDPE), associated manholes, services and asphalt at four (4) different project sites within the City of Lake Worth. Installation methods for the Additive Alternate bids includes open cut, pipe bursting, and CIPP construction methods. The City reserves the right to award none, some or all the Additive Alternates.

Bidders shall submit proposals in sealed envelopes upon the blank form of bid furnished. Proposals shall be sent to the Lake Worth City Hall, 3805 Adam Grubb, Lake Worth, Texas 76135. Sealed envelopes shall be marked "LAKE WORTH SANITARY SEWER REHABILITATION PROJECT - DO NOT OPEN UNTIL 10:00 AM FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 24, 2017".

No proposal may be changed, amended or modified by telegram or otherwise after the above time and date. A proposal may be, however, withdrawn and resubmitted any time prior to the time set for receipt of proposals.

Security in the form of Cashier's Check, Bid Bond or other negotiable instrument in the amount of 5% of the greatest amount bid must accompany each proposal as a guarantee that, if awarded the contract, the selected offeror will promptly enter into a contract and execute bonds and insurance as outlined in the specifications and Instructions to Bidders.

PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS and contract documents may be examined without charge at the Lake Worth City Hall, 3805 Adam Grubb, Lake Worth, Texas 76135. Copies of such instruments will be available for online purchase, Thursday, February 9, 2017 through CivCast at <http://www.civcastusa.com/> at cost dependent upon product ordered (full size plans, individual sheets, half size plans, project manuals).

Pursuant to Government Code Chapter 2269, subchapter D, the City may enter into a contract with the offeror meeting all the qualifications and specifications that submits a proposal that offers the best value to the City considering the selection criteria and weighted value set forth in the Instruction to Bidders and the ranking evaluation of the proposals received. The City reserves the right to reject any and all proposals and to waive informalities in submission of proposals.

In case of ambiguity or lack of clearness in stating bid prices, the Owner reserves the right to adopt the most advantageous construction thereof. No proposal may be withdrawn within forty-five (45) days after date on which proposals are opened.
